Evaluation of hepatoprotective activity of Ficus bengalensis

The hepatoprotective activity of methanolic extract of bark of *Ficus bengalensis* against paracetamol and CCl_4 induced liver damage was investigated. Treatment of rats with paracetamol and CCl_4 produced a significant increase in the levels of serum glutamate pyruvate transaminase SGPT, serum glutamate oxaloacetate transaminase SGOT, alkaline phosphatase ALP, total and direct *bilirubin*. Rats pretreated with methanolic extract of barks of *F. bengalensis* 100 and 250 mg/kg body weight p.o. exhibited rise in the levels of these enzymes but it was significantly less as compared to those treated with paracetamol or CCl4 alone. The results of methanolic extract of *F. bengalensis* were comparable with the standard hepatoprotective agent silymarin 100 mg/kg. Maximum hepatoprotective effect was found to be at the dose of 250 mg/kg body weight in case of CCl_4 induced hepatic damage while 500 mg/kg body weight in case of paracetamol induced hepatic damage. Obtained data suggest that methanolic extract of *F. bengalensis* bark possesses a potential antihepatoproxic activity.
