## Dental management of non-syndromic supernumerary teeth near the angel of mandibule

Supernumerary teeth are the teeth present in addition to the normal set of <u>teeth</u>. They may be single, multiple, Sunilateral or bilateral errupted or unerupted and in one or both jaws. Multiple supernumerary teeth are rare in individuals with no other associated diseases or syndromes. Our case presents with 4 <u>supernumerary teeth</u> in permanent dentition, and its unilateral in right lower jaw, patient have no sinus or pain, so the treatment follows up.
