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Figure 1: (a) Strong perioral, erythematous skin. (b) Pathological picture of extreme alveolar bone loss and degradation of PDL. (c) Bitewing radiographs that display isolated calcification in the space of the mandibular PDL. (d) Numerous molar and premolar removed teeth suggesting calcification inside and removing the PDL. Often present is dental calculus.

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
